- Disciplines:** Short Programme
Free Skating
- Competition Regulation:** For all matters not taken in consideration in the Technical Manual, the ISU General Rules 2010, Special Regulations & Technical rules for Singles & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2010 and all pertinent ISU Communications will be decisive.
- Ladies' Competition
Short Programme: Duration - max. 2 min. 50 sec. but may be less. The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical rules for Singles & Pair Skating 2010 Rule 511, paragraphs 1 and 3 for 2010/2011
Free Skating: Duration – 3 min. 30 sec. +/- 10 sec. In accordance with ISU Special Regulations & Technical rules for Singles & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2010, Rule 512 and the respective ISU Communication. Special Attention should be paid the „well balanced program“ and the element value.
- Men's Competition
Short Programme: Duration - max. 2 min. 50 sec, but may be less. The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical rules for Singles &



Pair Skating 2010 Rule 511, paragraphs 1 and 3 for 2010/2011

Free Skating: Duration – 4 min. +/- 10 sec. In accordance with ISU Special Regulations & Technical rules for Singles & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2010, Rule 512 and the respective ISU Communication. Special Attention should be paid the „well balanced program“ and the element value.

Entry deadlines: **15. 10. 2010** - 1st round EYOWF application (preliminary entries by numbers per sport)

15. 11. 2010 - 2nd round EYOWF application (final entries by numbers per sport)

15. 1. 2011 - 3rd round EYOWF application (entries by name – long list)

31. 1. 2011 - 4th round EYOWF application (final entries by name – short list)

Accommodation: via NOC according to general information – see www.eyowf2011.cz

Accreditation: via NOC according to general information – see www.eyowf2011.cz

Transportation: The organizer will provide shuttle bus service from the Olympic Village to the venue. Teams with their own cars should register these in advance during the accreditation process. After arrival teams will receive parking permissions for their car/cars. Without this permission you will be not able to go to the venue with your car!



Advertising:

According to EYOF Charter, Rule 15a.

No form of advertising or publicity may appear in any form whatsoever on clothing, accessories or, more generally, on any item of clothing or piece of equipment worn or carried by the delegations during the EYOWF, with the exception of the manufacturer's identification and logo, as stipulated in the rules of the IOC. All violations of the provisions of this clause shall lead to disqualification and the withdrawal of the accreditation of the person concerned.

Competition Office:

In the Olympic village - every day 8:00 – 20:00

At venue competition office, every day 8:00 – 20:00

Team Leaders' meetings:

According to official programme (see below) in the Olympic Village

Medical service:

Organiser will provide emergency medical service during trainings and competitions.

Insurance:

All athletes, officials and members of the National Olympic Committees who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk.

Organising Committee will arrange following insurance:

- Third party liability (personal injuries and damages).
- Basic medical costs and individual accidents (permanent disability, consequential damage).

All NOCs are nevertheless strongly advised to provide for an adequate insurance (travel insurance) policy for all members of their delegations.

The OC accepts no liability for bodily or personal injury, or for property loss or damage incurred by Competitors and Officials.



Judge's Nomination: Each participating ISU Member (National Figure Skating Association) may nominate 1 (one) International Judge, which must be listed in ISU Communication for season 2010/2011.

If the number of judges were to exceed the needs of the event the EYOWF 2011 o.p.s. will inform NOC after the Judges entries. Deadline for entries of Judges: 15th December, 2010.

The Organizer will cover the travel expenses for invited Referees, Technical Specialists and Technical Controller, the Data & Relay Operators only.

Panel of Judges: The panel of Judges will consist of seven (7) Judges according to the draw at the Judges Meeting.

Music / Planned Content Sheets: All Competitors shall provide competition music in excellent quality in CD format. In accordance with Rule 343 ISU Special Regulations & Technical rules for Singles & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2010, the music must be correctly signed. If music information is not complete and discs are not provided, competitor will be not allowed to start.

With the entry forms, the Programme Content Sheet must be returned to OC before 4th February, 2011. It is required that the Programme Content Sheet be filled in precisely by each skater in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication.

Sport Facilities: Liberec – Svižanska Arena
The Arena is an indoor ice rink with an ice surface of 59 x 28 m.

Ceremonies: After each competition there will be a flower ceremony at the venue (best 3 athletes / teams). Medal ceremony (best 3 athletes / teams) will be organized in the Olympic Village – see general programme at www.eyowf2011.cz.



Participation conditions:

Each competitor must be nominated by National Association and meet the age conditions mentioned on page 1 under Category

Liability:

In accordance with Rule 119, the OC and the ISU accept no liability for bodily or personal injury, or for property loss or damage incurred by Competitors and Officials. Each ISU Member is expected to provide its own instance protection. The OC will provide emergency medical service for all invited Officials and Competitors during the event.

Results:

The marking system (ISU Judging System) as described in Technical Rule Singles&Pair Skating 2010, Rule 352 and Rule 353 (Determination and publication of results) or all pertinent amendments and ISU Communications will be decisive.
