

# Kateřina Nyčová: INTERVIEW OF THE MONTH EYOWF prepared by dream team!



I have mixed feelings. On one hand, what is strongest is a certain nostalgia and sadness that it is all over. It is always this way with big events and productions. You work hard on them, live with them and with the people taking part in the preparations and then the event passes so quickly that suddenly it is over. The Organising Committee, which lived as one big family, is dissolved and everyone feels empty and alone. After years of working on the organisation of sporting events I am used to it, but it does not mean I feel the same every time. Because EYOWF was a really big event, I feel it more intensely. But on the other hand I feel happy, not only because the event was successful, but also because there was a great team of people working on it.

### What was the main reason for the event's success?

I think we could apply the old saying "Train hard, fight easy." © Undoubtedly the key to success was the hard work done during the preparations, the great bunch of people gathered to work together. And then it is the unknown factor X. We can call it luck. Every

organiser needs it. And we did have luck.

### In what ways was this year's EYOWF different from the previous events?

It is hard to say. It is a question for the participants, but according to their reactions and responses we could say they were satisfied. With accommodation, food, sporting programme... For the first time in the history of EYOWF we used technology for sending multiple info text messages from our information system and this was warmly welcomed. What also contributed greatly to the overall good atmosphere and smooth running was the compactness of the whole event. Everybody lived in one place - the Olympic Village, and perhaps with the exception of Snowboarding, all the venues were within a short distance of the common accommodation. The athletes were happy in the so-called Fun Zone, where they spent their free time. For the first time during a Winter Festival, we have also held an Observer Programme - an information seminar for future event organisers. There were some good points. ©
