- minority volunteers – in total 28 in 4 sports venues

- checking the observance`s codes and regulations

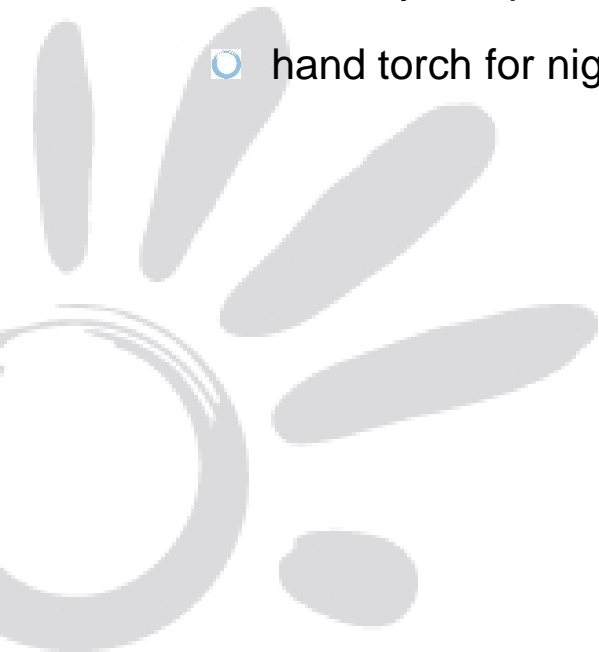
Clothing and Equipment

Education training and workers checking up

Security agency

- were informed and educated within during 3 months before the EYOWF 2011
- responsible for blamelessness of their workers

Volunteers

- trained at the Security meeting (December 2010)
- trained and educated via emails
- not checked up (criminal record, psychological test)

Costs

- 🎨 Expenses before EYOWF
 - Security manager and two Security assistants

- 🎨 During EYOWF
 - Professional Security workers

- 🎨 After EYOWF
 - Security manager (closing process, mainly paperwork)

Major milestones

- 🎨 Security Department works since - May 2010
- 🎨 Meetings with IRS – Integrated Rescue System - every month
- 🎨 Selection procedure of Security agency - December 2010
- 🎨 Volunteers introduction - December 2010
