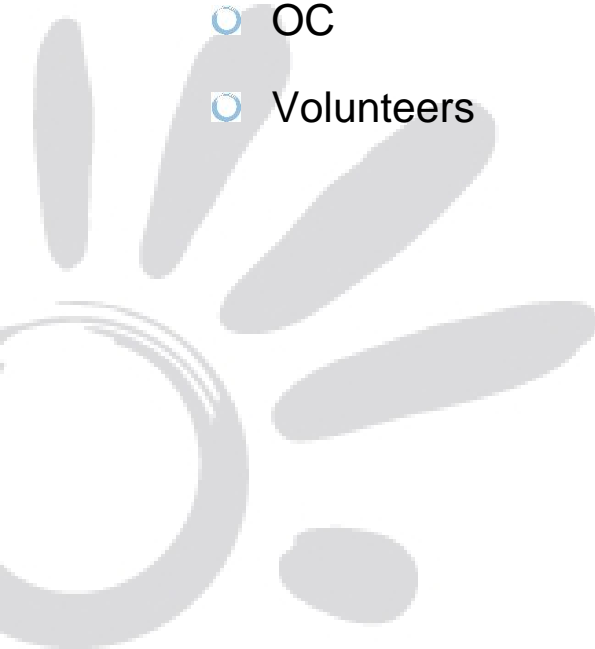

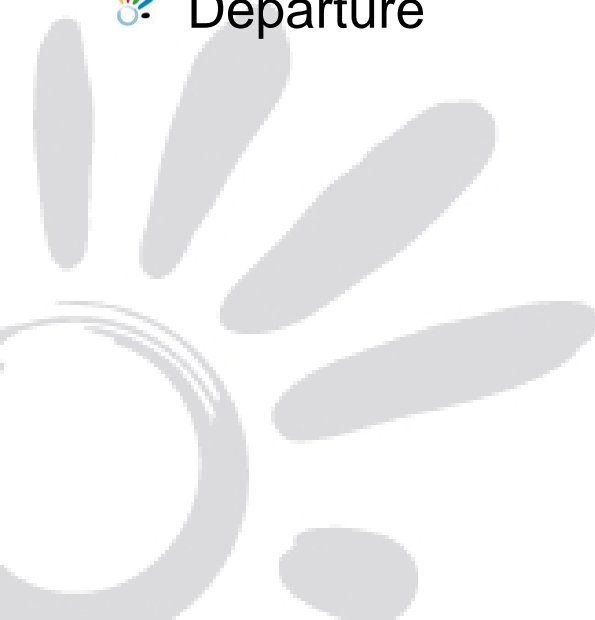

Transportation possibilities 1/3

Own vehicles

- Delegations/teams/media must receive accreditation and pick up VAP (vehicle access permit) at the OLV and only then may:
 - take their equipment to the venues
 - park at places according their accreditation

OC shuttle bus for teams

- Information at the welcome desks – at both arrival halls in the Prague – Ruzyně Airport
- At the airport - buses with extra luggage space for teams
- Transportation to the OLV
- Transportations of the equipment to the venues (team cabins)
- IH teams will each drive in a special bus loaded with their luggage directly from the airport to the Ice Hockey venue then to the OLV

Public transportation

- for accredited people for free

Transportation possibilities 2/3

Shuttle Bus Service

- The bus service runs on special lines according to a fixed timetable
- Timetable will take into consideration the sport programme and requirements of each sport
- Timetable – in block's entrance halls, NOC Services center, websites, bus stops

- Transport of individuals or smaller groups mostly not according to fixed timetable is provided in accordance to the specific or individual needs (VANs, personal cars)

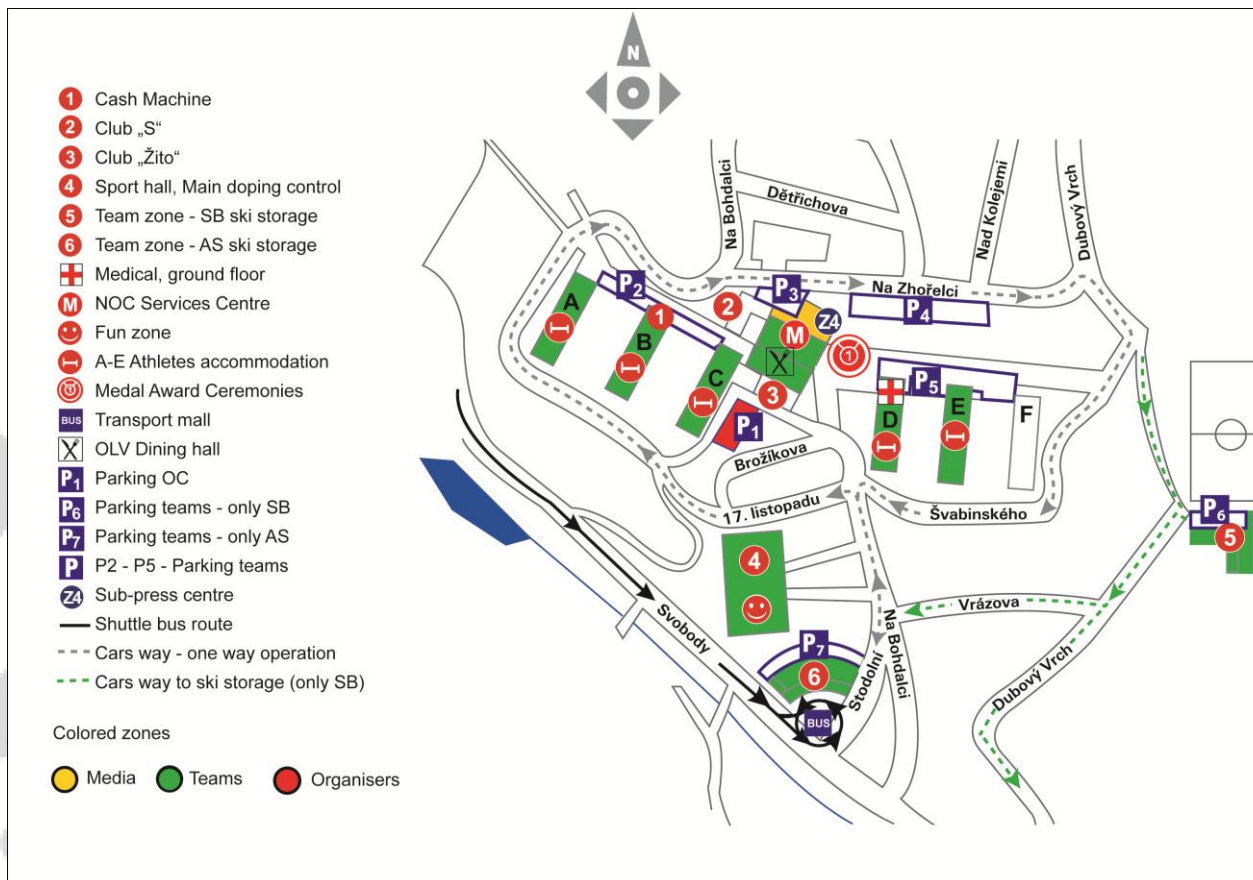
Transportation possibilities 3/3

City line

- the line from the Olympic Village to the Official EOC hotel, city centre and to the Tipsport arena, dormitory Vesec and the same way back
- operates at regular intervals

Transportation at the Olympic Village



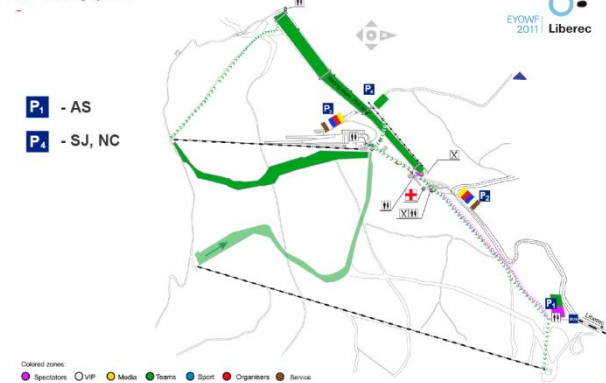
VAP – Vehicle access permit

- Parking system at each venue and the OLV operating on parking and access cards (VAP)
 - Placed on windscreen
 - VAP will be coloured – based on the application form completed in IS
 - Parking for teams at every venue (limited number of cars)

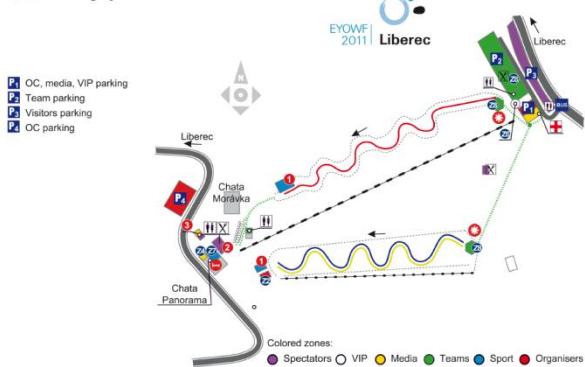

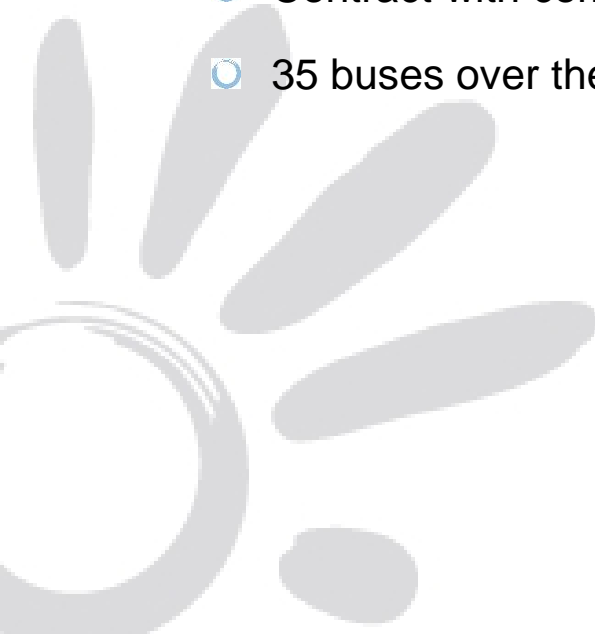
Major points

Transportation partner - Škoda Auto

- 45 personal cars
- 5 multivans

Bus transport

- Contract with company
- 35 buses over the festival



Recommendations

Information input

- Control, control, control

Bus timetables

- Changes in buses timetables
- Be careful to print initial timetables into the manual before the festival start
- Athletes were not well informed by Chefs de Mission (communication problem from CdeM to athletes)

Be flexible, operative and have enough reserves (cars, buses)

Communication to Transport Volunteers
